## White Wine

- 01 **Santana White {Spain}**  
Clean and fresh on the nose with herbaceous and herbal characteristics blending with citrus fruits. The palate is fresh and zappy in a dry, easy drinking style. (1)

- 02 **San Alessandro Trebbiano-Pinot Grigio {Puglia, Italy}**  
Light and delicate style with floral notes and a lime and sherbet touch. (2)

- 03 **Sepa Moya Sauvignon Blanc {Central Valley, Chile}**  
Mouth-wateringly refreshing, like sheer Andean dew melt. Bags of citrus and tropical fruit character and full of zest. Fresh yet satisfying, this is textbook Chilean Sauvignon. (2)

- 04 **Les Vignerons Muscat-Viognier {Languedoc, South of France}**  
Pale in colour, with golden hues, this refreshing, lively wine offers intense flavours such as peach and citrus, with floral hints. Crisp and zesty, the palate has excellent balance and elegant finish. (2)

- 05 **Billycan Chardonnay {South East Australia}**  
Australia has moved away from heavy, oaky, simple white wines and this Chardonnay shows their new improved style. Light and fresh with crisp green apple character. (2)

- 06 **Gravel & Loam Sauvignon Blanc {Marlborough, New Zealand}**  
Intense gooseberry aromas alongside fresh herbaceous and grassy notes. Vibrant passion fruit, citrus and peach characters with top notes of melon and kiwi balanced with softer apple and white pear flavours. Well structured zesty acidity with fantastic length and elegance. (1)

- 07 **Chablis Alain Geoffroy {Chablis, Burgundy, France}**  
Fragrant flowers, fruity aromas with sweet, suave scents. A pronounced mineral character enhances the fruit flavours. (1)

- 08 **Shoreline Lyme Bay {Devon, England}**  
A wine for seafood; dry and refreshing with complex layers. This beautiful wine has subtle notes of rose petal, lemon, nettle and grapefruit. (2)

## Rosé Wine

- 09 **Santana Rosado {Spain}**  
Appealing rose pink colour and soft and attractive aromas on the nose, reminiscent of strawberries and cream with just a hint of raspberries. Dry style rosé, great with food. (2)

- 10 **Island Fox Zinfandel Blush {Puglia, Italy}**  
This is Italy's take on the ever-popular sweet Zinfandel rosé that California does so well! It is sweet and juicy with fruit salad flavours, a lighter body and lower alcohol. (4)

- 11 **Laroma Pinot Grigio Rosato Botter {Veneto, Italy}**  
As pleasing a Pinot Grigio rosé as you could find. It has freshness, delicacy and rose-scented charm all the way through. (2)

## Red Wine

- 12 **Santana Red {Spain}**  
Like a young Rioja this wine has raspberries, cherries and spice aromas, well integrated tannins with just a hint of liquorice to taste. (B)

- 13 **Sepa Moya Merlot {Central Valley, Chile}**  
Chile's signature red, with instantly recognisable plum, mocha and spice notes on the nose, abundant fruit on the palate, and a long finish. The oak influence is very subtle, the fruit forthright and pure. (C)

- 14 **Billycan Shiraz {South East Australia}**  
Here's a juicy fruity Aussie red with balanced alcohol to give a deliciously easy drinking Shiraz. It's time to rediscover just how good the wines from Down Under are tasting. (B)

- 15 **Cormoran Tempranillo {Rioja, Spain}**  
Bright cherry red with masses of red berry fruit flavours leading into richer, warmer fruits with a hint of vanilla. Well-balanced, lingering and harmonious. (B)

- 16 **Rue des Amis Pinot Noir {Languedoc, South of France}**  
Exceptionally smooth with soft tannins, red fruit aromas and cherry flavours. A lighter red and very food friendly. (B)

- 17 **The Butcher of Buenos Aires Malbec {Mendoza, Argentina}**  
Attractive notes of sweet black cherry and a silky smooth mouthfeel. Not a heavy Malbec but one designed to be versatile with food yet easy enough to drink on its own. (C)

- 18 **Côtes du Rhône Auguste Bessac {Côtes du Rhône, France}**  
Young and well-ripened, this Rhône red is wonderfully easy-drinking with light berry fruit style. (B)

- 19 **Cormoran Crianza {Rioja, Spain}**  
Dark cherry red. Clean with intense ripe fruit, liquorice and toasted notes. This wine is rich and rounded in the mouth with a lovely long finish. (C)

- 20 **Nos Amours Brut {South of France}**  
A wonderfully quaffable fizz for any occasion with aromas of butter and cake. A fresh and harmonious sparkling wine. (1)

- 21 **Prosecco Borgo SanLeo {Veneto, Italy}**  
Intense floral, fruity bouquet. A wonderfully fresh and well-balanced, appley palate with just a hint of delicate almond. (1)

Brut, but with ripe, sunny fruit flavours and biscuity depth and structure from the black grapes in the blend. (1)
